The Dutch master brought artistry and elegance to Arsenal's attack. His technical brilliance and iconic goals made him one of the Premier League's greatest players.

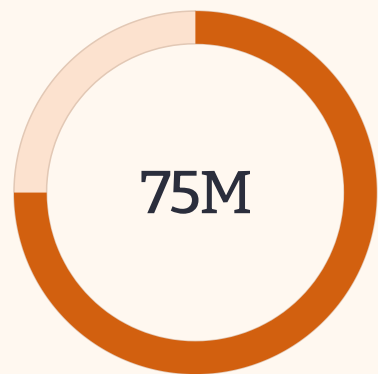


**Patrick Vieira**

The commanding French midfielder captained the Invincibles and defined Arsenal's dominance in the early 2000s with his leadership, power, and technical ability.

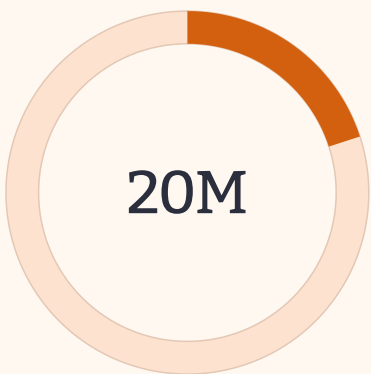

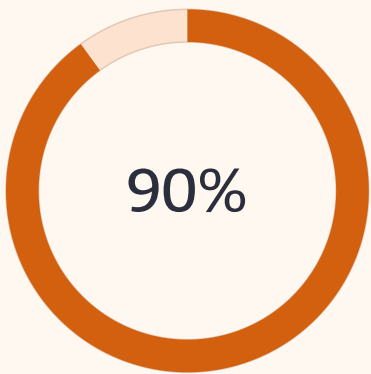
